SHOULDER TO SHOULDER: GERMAN -FRENCH COOPERATION

At ILA Berlin 2018, France and Germany gave the green light to Europe's most ambitious defense project. Airbus and Dassault Aviation have agreed to combine their resources and collaborate to develop and construct Europe's Future Combat Air System – FCAS.







FRANCO-GERMAN DEFENSE PROJECTS

French Defense Minister Florence Parly noted that this was a "historic agreement." It was necessary to make the armed forces of both countries "more powerful, modern and versatile" by 2040, to ensure they had a strategic advantage and to create a "Europe focused on defense."





SOLDIERS IN CLOSE UP

Presenting all the different facets of the Bundeswehr: Over 40 aircraft could be viewed on the ground. Also possible for visitors: A tour around the A310 MRTT, the chance to sit in a cockpit of a Tornado and a close look at military helicopters such as the TIGER combat helicopter or the navy's Sea Lynx and Sea King. One of the main highlights was the flyby of a total of 20 aircraft including the Eurofighter, A400M and NH-90.



FACING THE FUTURE

ILA Berlin 2018 fosters dialogue between high-ranking generals, leading politicians working on defense and security issues as well as defense industry experts and cybersecurity researchers. In the Military Support Center, the industry and the military presented a wide-range of successful cooperations between defense forces and industrial partners.
